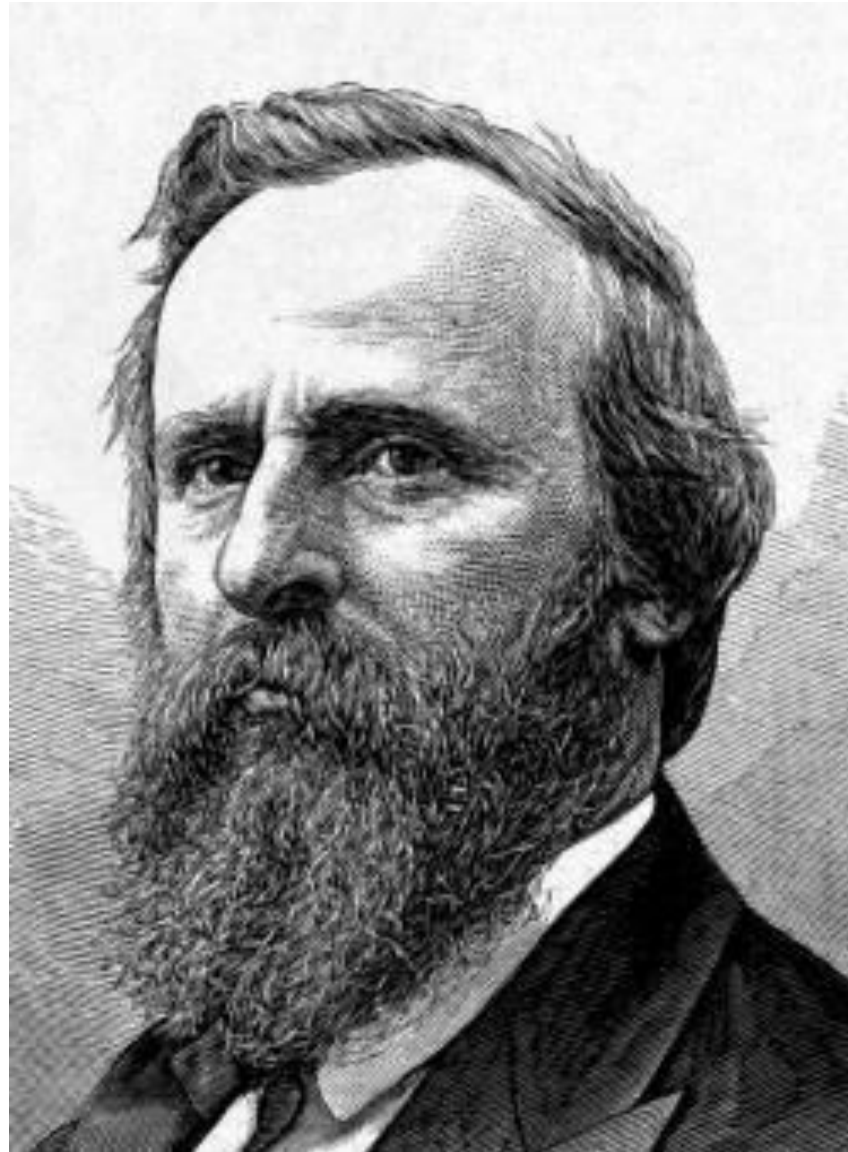
I. President Grant

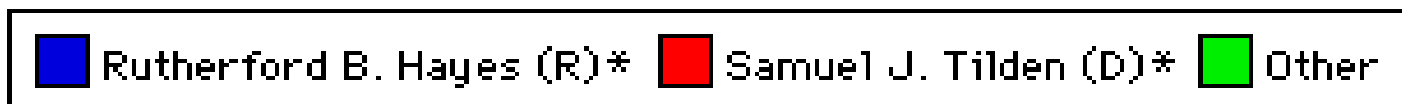
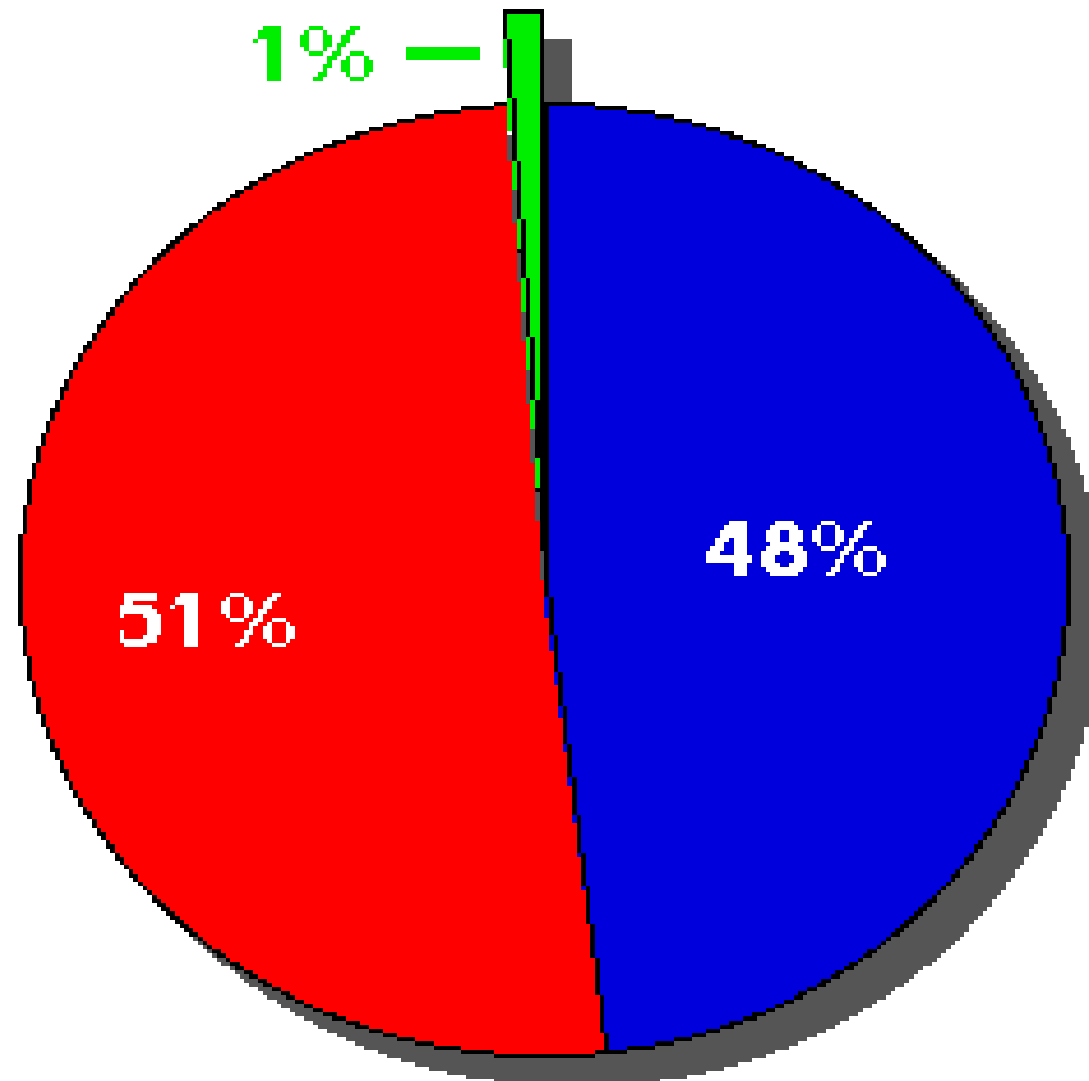

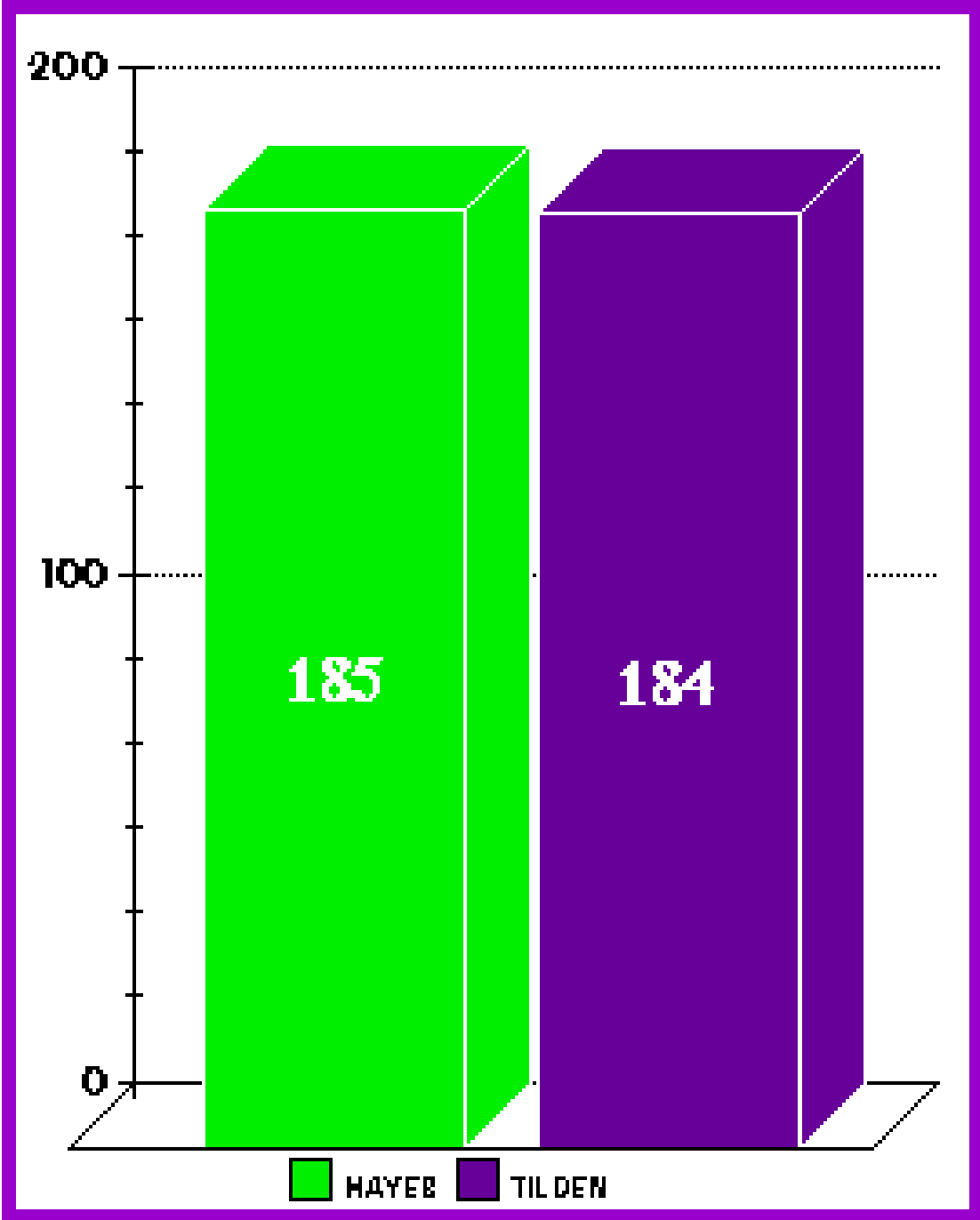
III. The Compromise of 1877

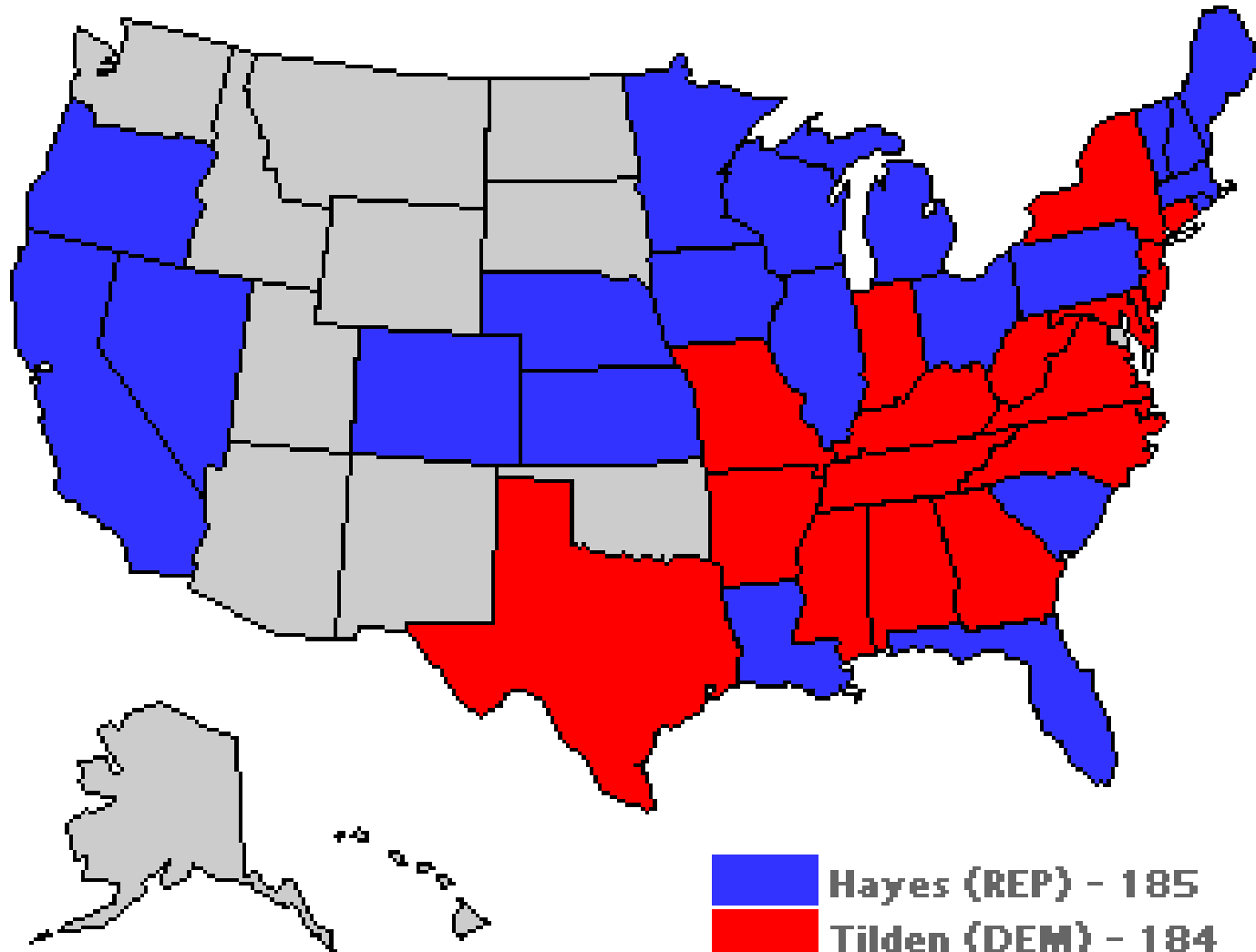
- Northern Republicans want the presidency.

***Hayes won the election.**



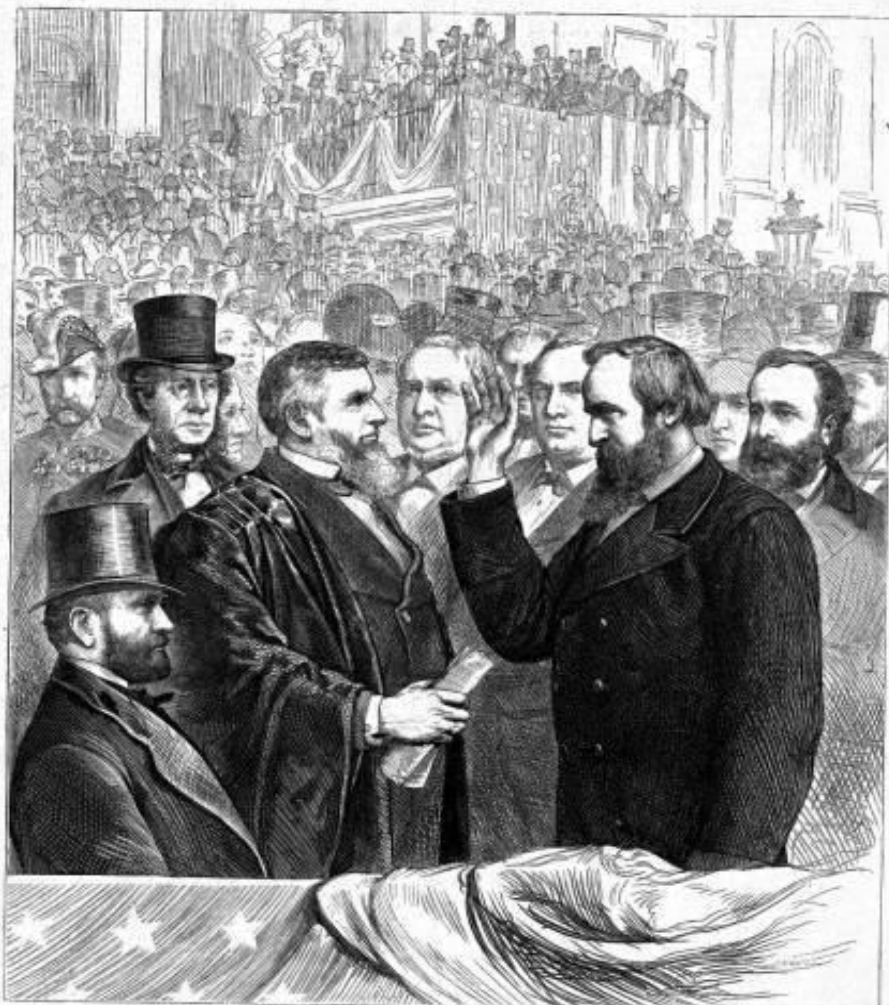

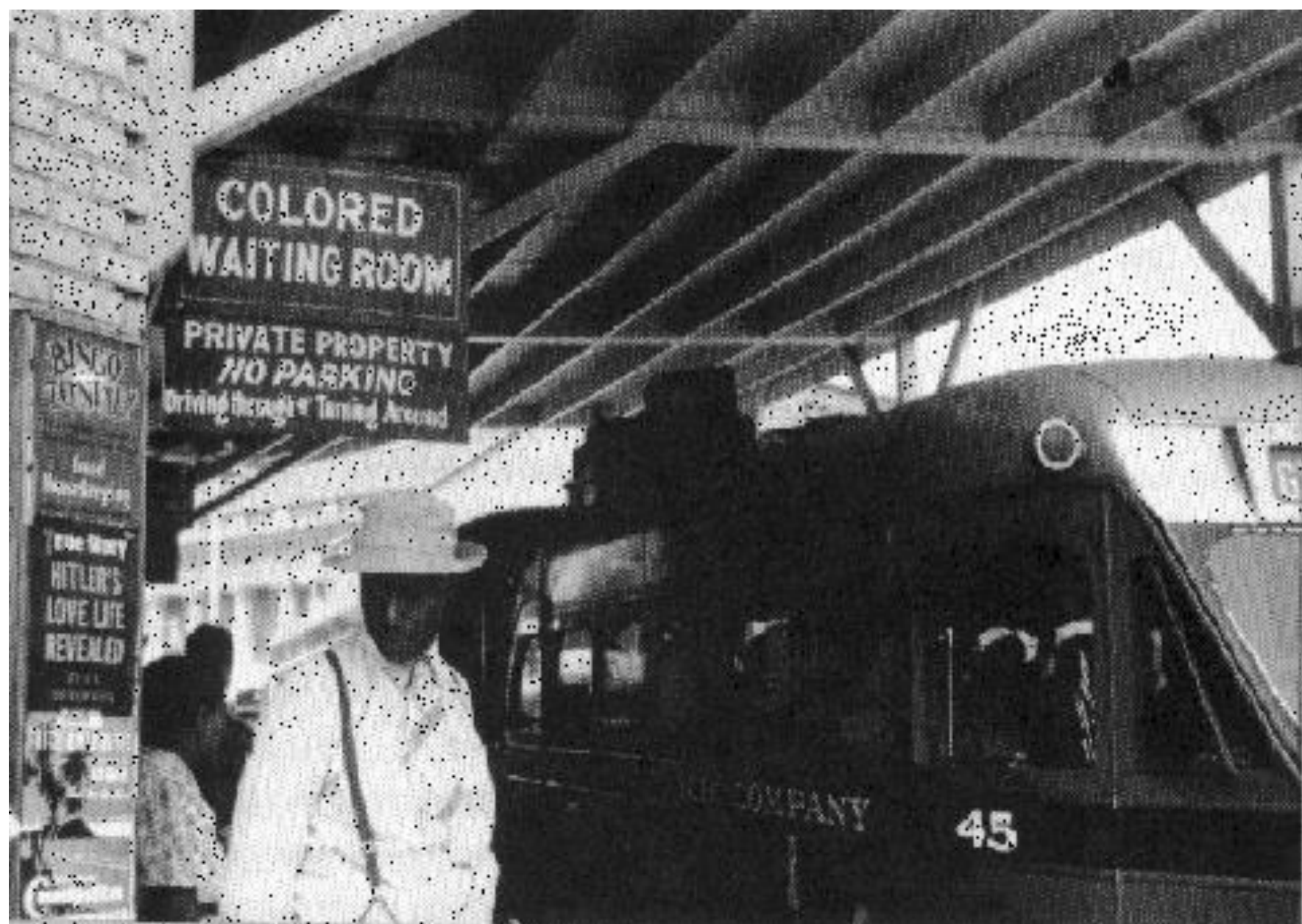
