- Fresh American troops “doughboys” were too much for the Central Powers to deal with.
- Germany was exhausted.

- On October 4, 1918 the Germans ask President Wilson for an Armistice.
- War officially ends November 11, 1918, at 11am.
- Germans face starvation, fresh troops, over 1 million dead.
