


I. Johnson Vs. Congress

- President Johnson continues to veto laws/acts/programs sent by the Radical Republicans.
- Those programs/laws helped freedmen and angered South
- Many Republicans seek to Impeach Johnson.



- Congress passes a law making it illegal for a president to fire a cabinet member without Congressional approval.
- · The Tenure of Office Act.



- The Republicans know that Johnson wants to Fire Secretary of War Edwin Stanton.
- Stanton is a Radical Republican and hates Johnson.

• President Johnson is charged with high crimes and misdemeanors for his firing of Stanton.

- His trial begins on April 6th 1868.
- · Johnson wins by one vote!!
