- In 1899, Secretary of State John Hay tried to assure economic opportunity for the United States.
- He asked the European powers to keep an "open door" to China.
- He wanted to ensure through his <u>Open Door</u> <u>Policy</u> that the United States would have fair access to the Chinese markets.

THE BOXER REBELLION

AMERICAN IMPERIALISM

- In 1900, a secret patriotic Chinese society called the Boxers attacked missionaries, diplomats, and other foreigners in China in what is known as the <u>Boxer Rebellion</u>.
- The Boxers were revolting against the Manchu Dynasty and against the intervention of Western powers in China.
