
- •<u>Lend-lease</u>: FDR will lend the weapons to England in return for use of English naval bases for 99 years.

- •The United States considers an embargo of all oil and scrap metal products to Japan.
- ·Japan warns against such a move.

- •In the summer of 1941 FDR freezes all Japanese assets in the U.S.
- •Stops all oil sales and scrap metal sales.
- ·Japan is OUTRAGED.
