I. Moving Toward War

- **Japanese** aggression in **China** leads to warnings from the **United States**.
- **Japan** ignores warnings.

- The **United States** considers an embargo of all **oil** and **scrap metal** products to **Japan**.
- **Japan** warns against such a move.

- In the summer of 1941 FDR freezes all Japanese assets in the U.S.
- Stops all oil sales and scrap metal sales.
- Japan is OUTRAGED.
