




- Elected Vice-President to William McKinley in 1900

- · Teddy was mountain climbing















































































- His presidency is often known as a SQUARE DEAL

- Expands the role of government to help ordinary people.
- The exact opposite of Laissez-Faire.
- · Government becomes involved in conservation, helping the poor, and trust busting.
- TR broke up J.P. Morgan's giant Monopoly Northern Securities Co.
- · "The TRUSTBUSTER"
