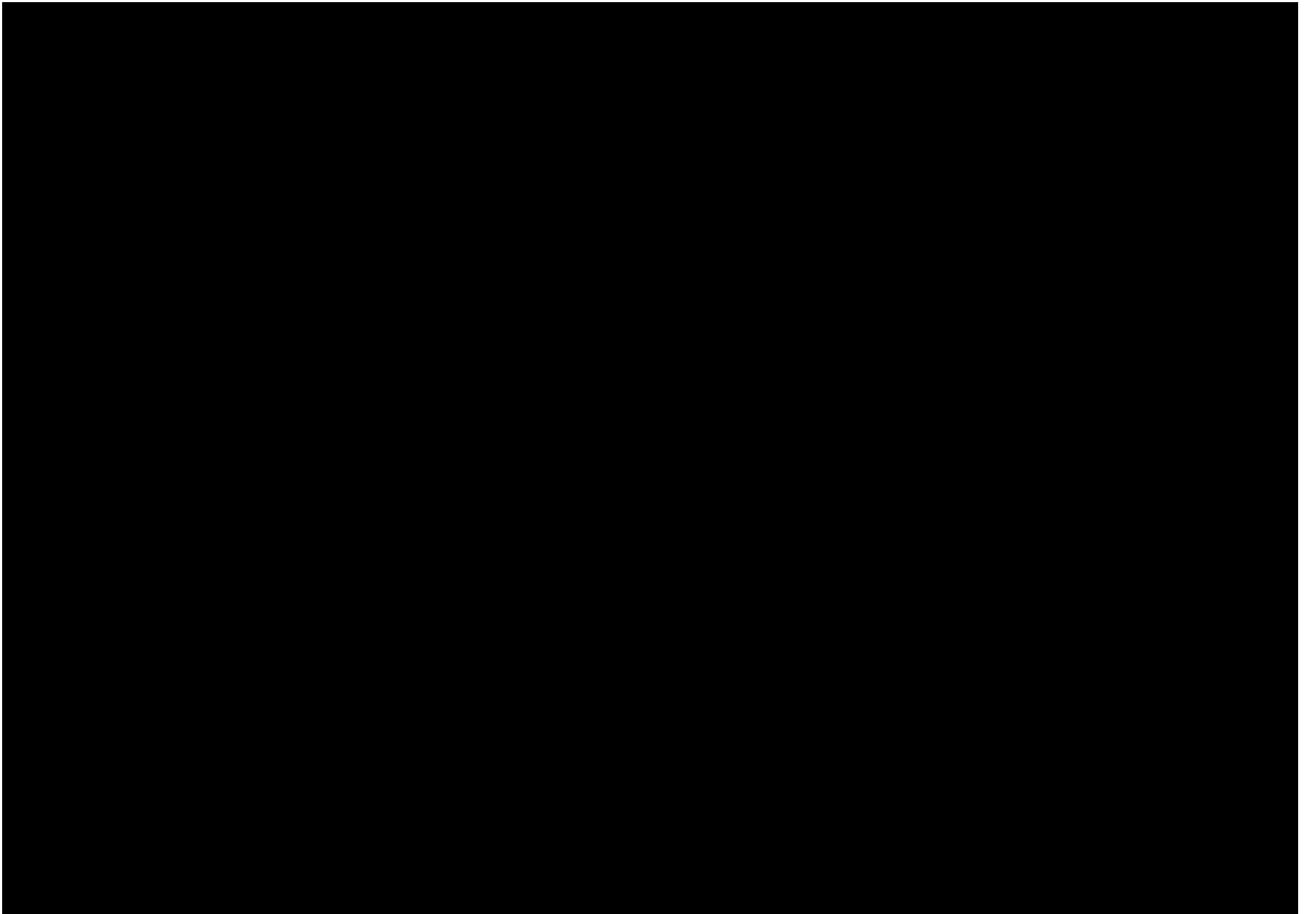

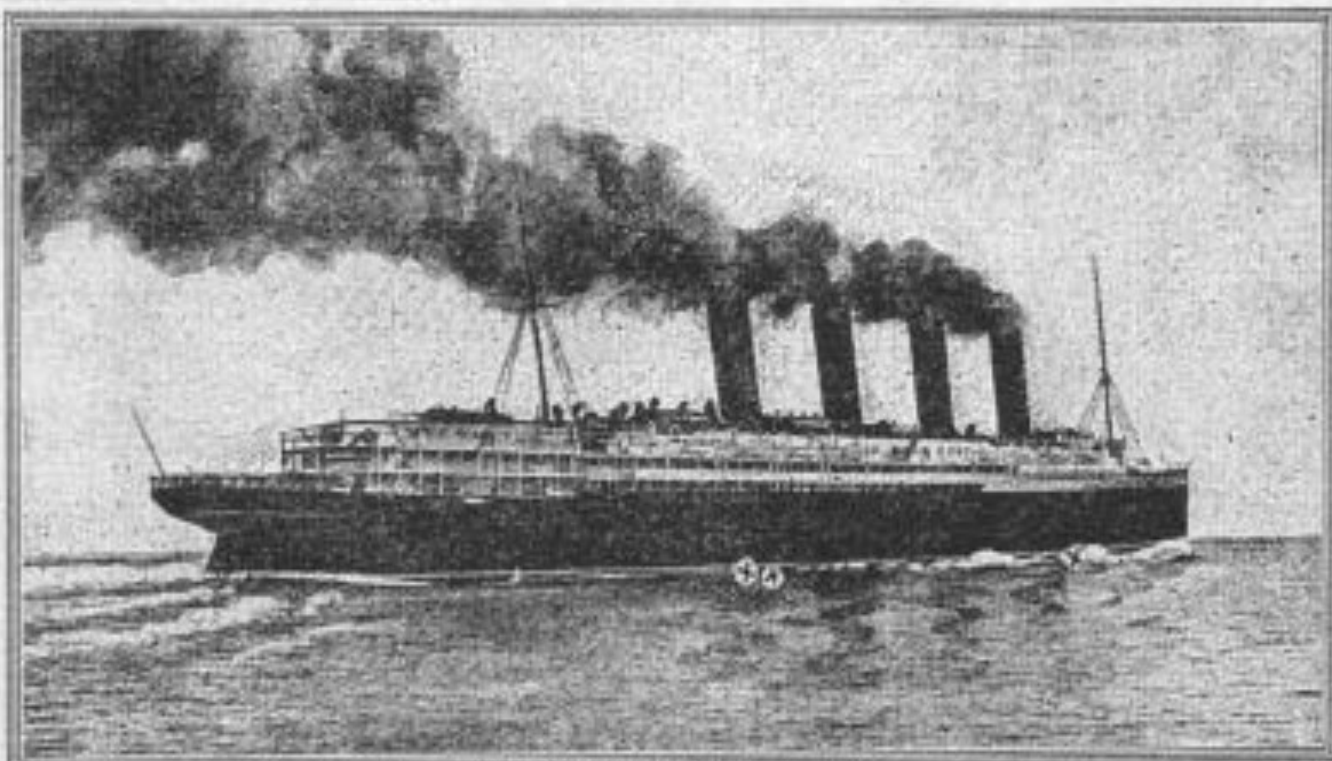
### SENATE OF CONGRESS CALL

WASHINGTON, May 7. — News here here early today that the Lusitania had been sunk, and Washington had no word as to its fate until the middle of the afternoon. 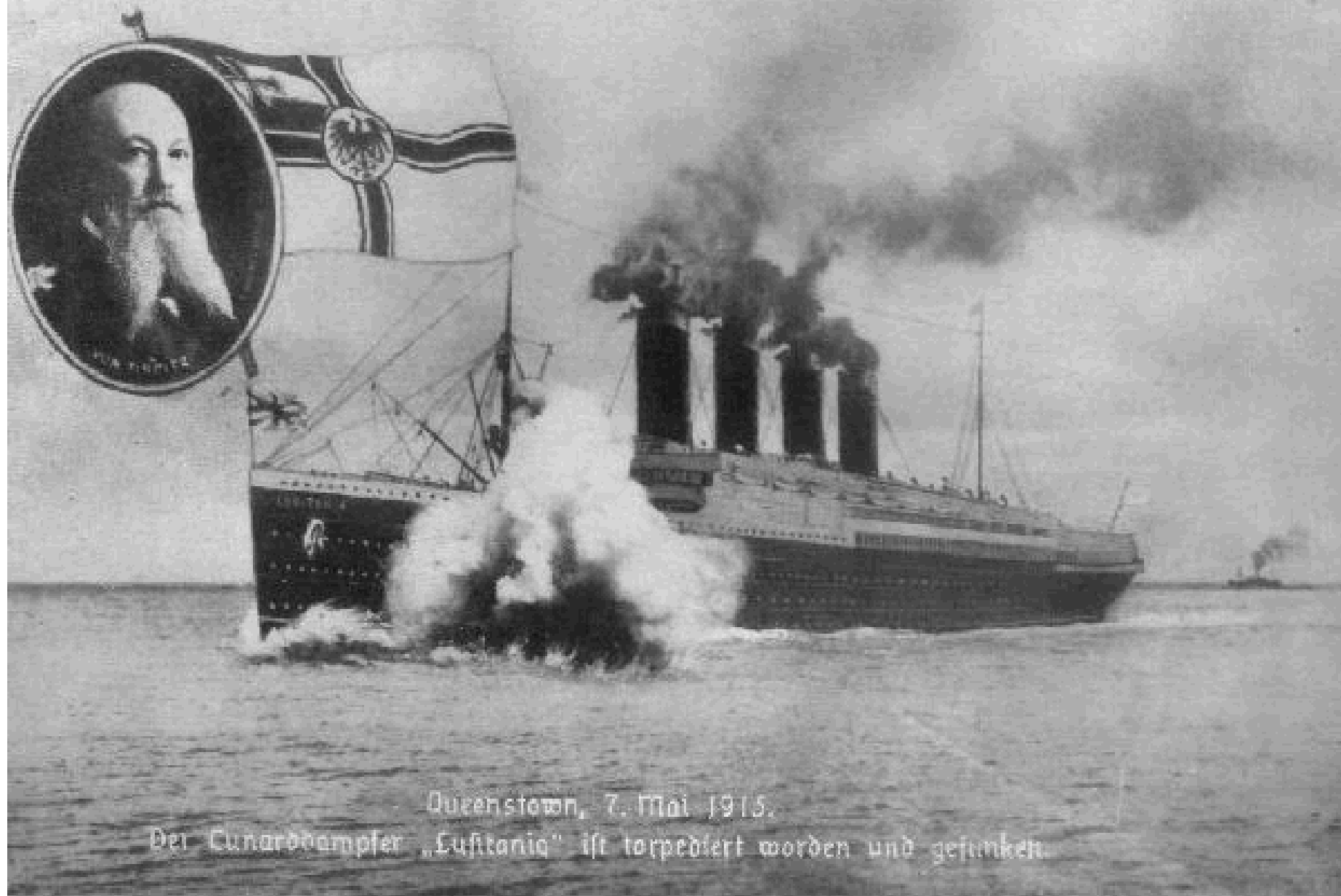
### ATTACKED IN BROAD DAY

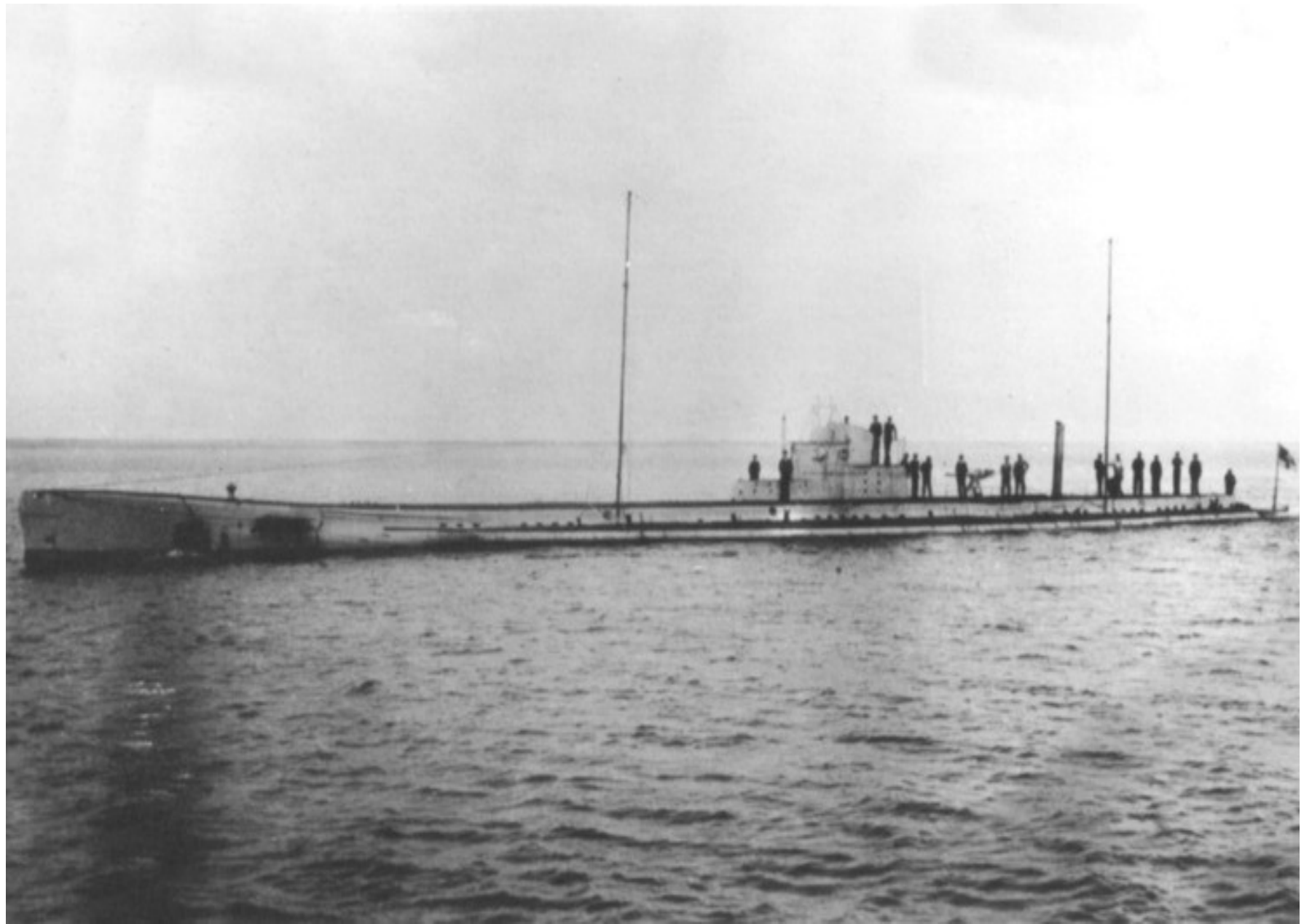


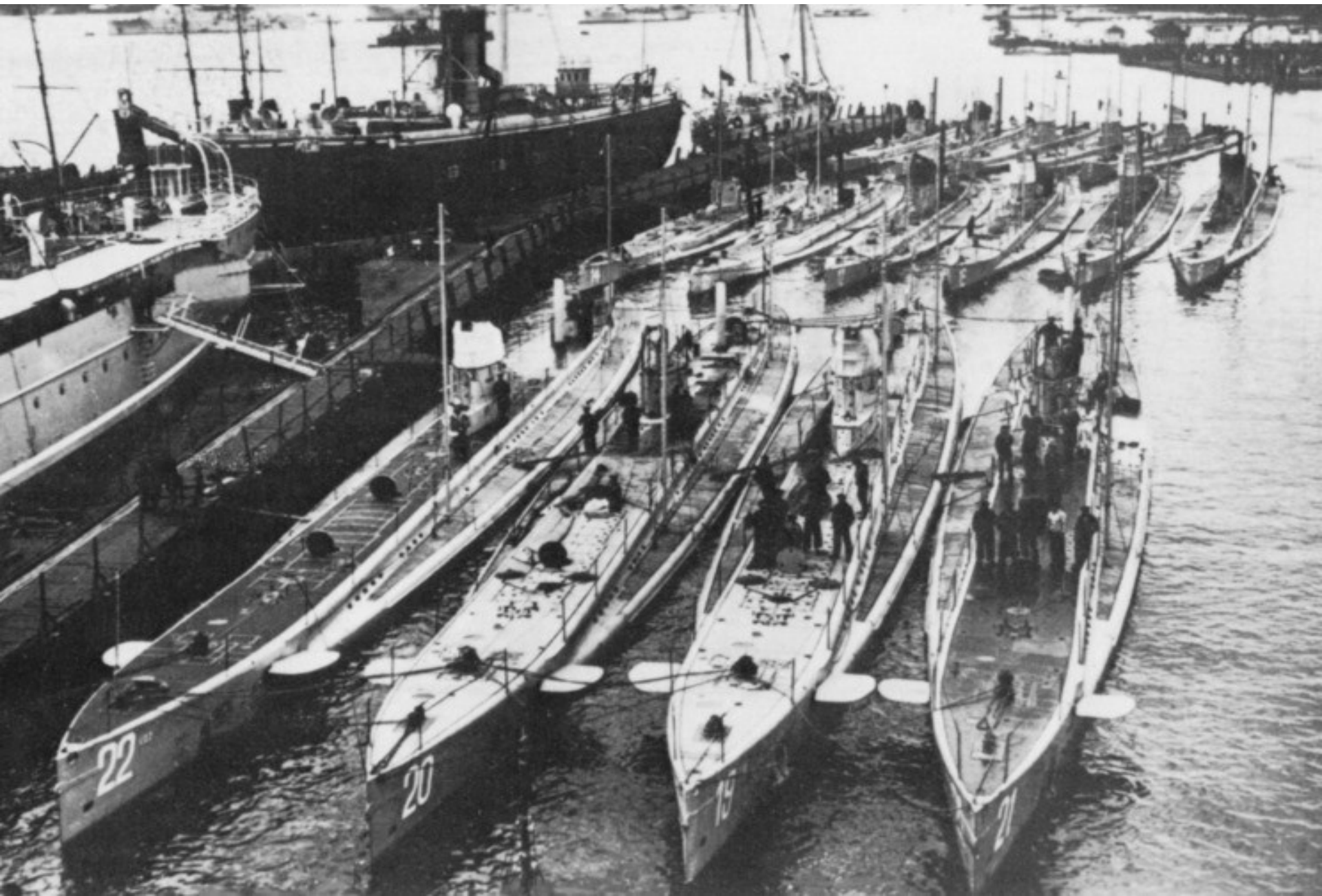


Queenstown, 7. Mai 1915.

A popular German postcard issued to commemorate the sinking of the "Lusitania."

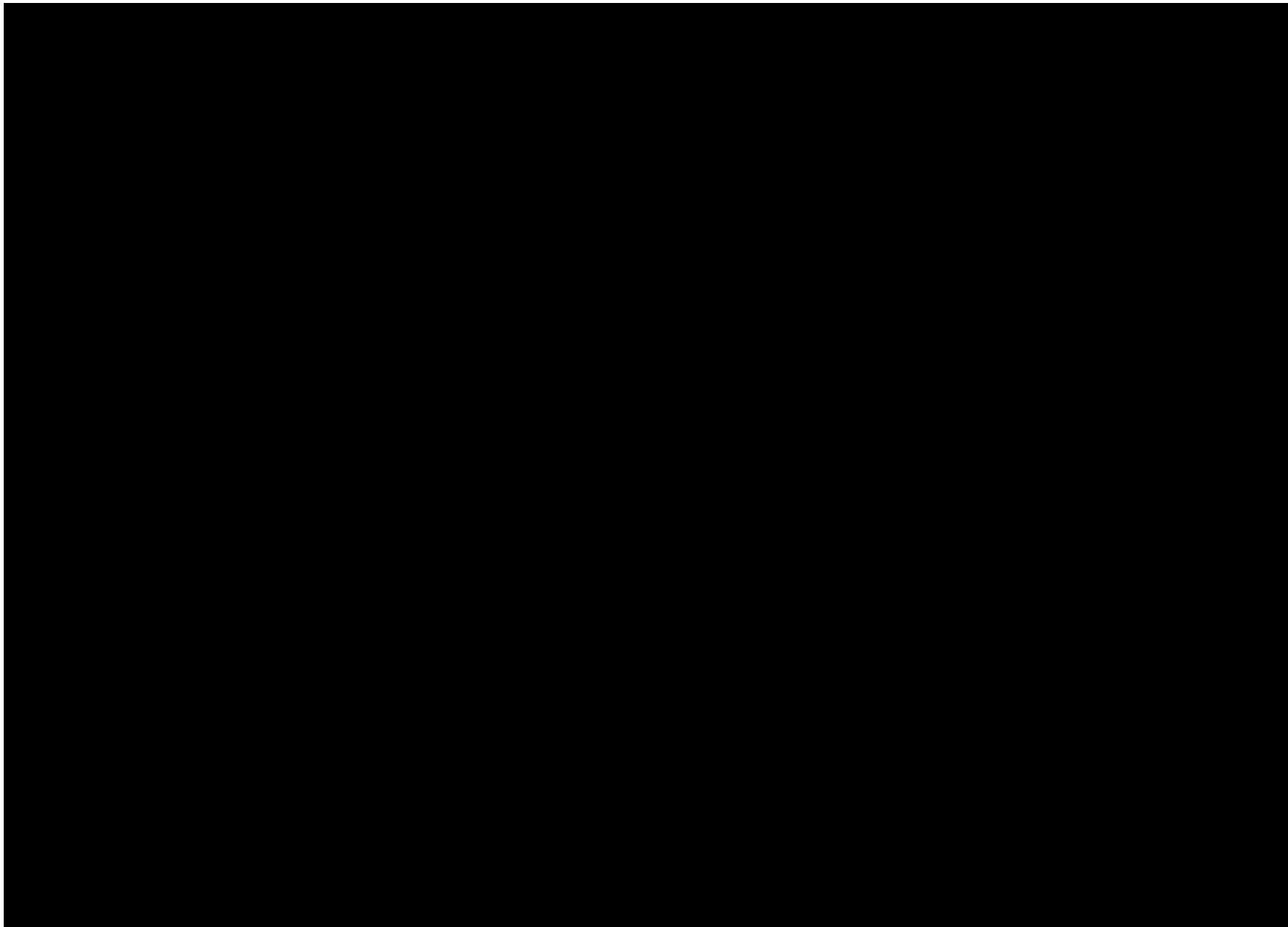






# I The Lusitania

- **128 Americans die on the ship.**
- **The ship may have been carrying war materials to England.**



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
