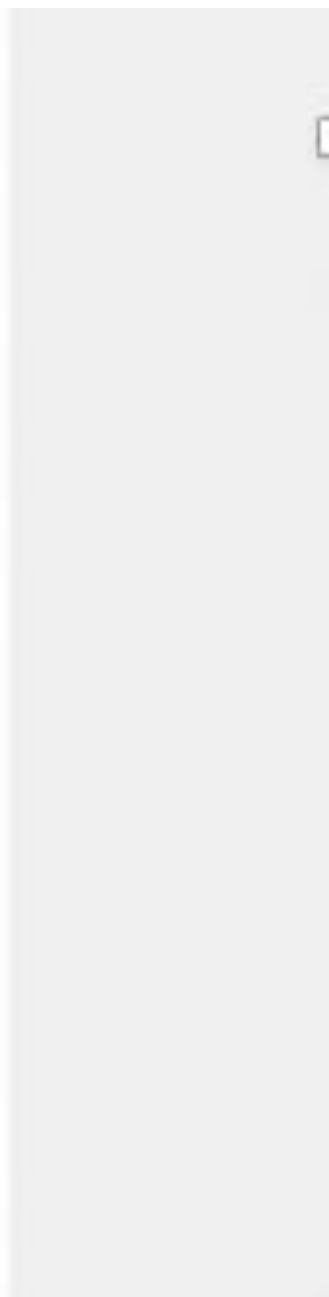

I. Black Codes

- Laws set up by **southern states** to keep **Freedmen** in a state of slavery.
- Freedmen cannot:
- Serve on Juries, Vote in local elections, hold office, marry a white person, hold any job except on a farm or as a servant.

I. Voting Schemes

- **Poll tax**: forces freedmen to pay a tax before voting.
- **Literacy Test**: Freedmen must read and write before voting.
- **Grandfather Clause**: If your grandfather was a slave you cannot vote.

II. The KU KLUX KLAN

- Formed in 1866 by **General Nathan Bedford Forrest.**
- Used intimidation and violence to scare Freedmen. (Voting.)
- In Florida the Klan killed more than 150 people from 1866-1869.
