

Allied forces land in France and push towards Germany






I. Allied Success in Europe


- *successful landing on the beaches of Normandy (June 6, 1944- D-Day) led to a steady flow of troops towards Germany

- ·By December 1944 Hitler is pushed back to Germany









- ·Kamikaze Pilots


- •An estimated 1,000,000

- ·Men, Women, and Children would fight to the death





II. The Atomic Bomb


- <u>Potsdam declaration</u>: Truman to Japan, "surrender or face destruction."

- <u>August 6, 1945</u> the Enola Gay drops the first bomb on <u>Hiroshima.</u>





After the blast




- August 9, second bomb dropped on Nagasaki.

- ·Several thousand more will die days later.
- ·Both cities destroyed.

- ·V-J Day August 15, 1945.
- · August 15, 1945 Japan surrenders.
