

Code of Conduct and Etiquette for Elementary Physical Education

As Physical Educators, our main objective is the health and well being of all students. We will be abiding by all CDC guidelines if not exceeding them during Physical Education classes. Please read and sign this form so we know you understand the new rules we are implementing.

Physical Education will look very different this year. We will do our best to make it as enjoyable as possible while still abiding by CDC guidelines.

1. All students are expected to come to PE class prepared. (Sneakers and comfortable clothing suitable for activity.) Students who are not wearing proper clothing/sneakers will be asked to watch from their spots. They will be marked unprepared.
2. Students will wash or sanitize their hands prior to and returning from PE.
3. Weather permitting, we will be taking all PE classes outdoors. We want the students to get up out of their chairs for their time with us. As weather gets cooler, please dress accordingly.
4. While walking in hallways as well as out to the fields, students are to wear their masks. Once outside in their new “floor spots”, students will be permitted to remove masks, while remaining in their spots which are spaced more than 6ft. apart.
5. We will be using minimal shared equipment. This is one reason why students are to wash/sanitize their hands prior to class. All equipment will be sanitized daily as per NYSED guidelines.
6. Students will be allowed to keep masks off as long as they are at least 6ft. apart. Once they are closer than 6ft., masks must be on.

7. At the end of each class, students will be asked to put their masks back on as they return to their class. Students will be asked to wash or sanitize their hands upon return to their classrooms.
8. All Remote Learners will have assignments posted in their respective platforms.

As long as all students abide by the above rules, we can continue outdoor PE classes. If students are not abiding by these rules, we will need to keep students indoors and in their classrooms for PE. This is NOT what we want, and we are sure this is not what you want.
