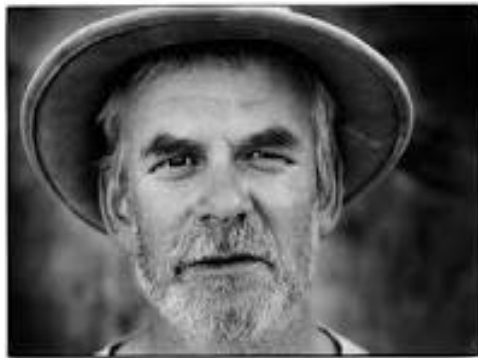


Family Art Activity: Make an Earth Art Mandala

A mandala is a circular design, often showing radial symmetry, that evolved from Hindu and Buddhist cultures. Earth artists like Andy Goldsworthy and James Brunt gather natural resources from their surroundings and create art with it. Your challenge is to gather natural resources and make a mandala on the ground. When you are gathering materials, think of their color, shape and size. Look for things like sticks, leaves, rocks, pine cones and stones. Start in the middle and work your way around the circle, making each part of the design repeat around the circle.
