I hope that you and your families are well. It is well publicized in the news that there has been a surge in positive COVID cases. Our current data reflects this increase. Since the last letter dated December 21, 2021, there have been 225 COVID cases.

Individuals receiving a positive test result are required to isolate for ten days as per the Department of Health guidelines.
