Additional Remote Learning Mandate

- During the first week in August, the administrative team began planning a remote learning option given the results from the surveys and conversations with parents.
- On August 7, 2020, Governor Cuomo announced that in addition to complying with previously released Department of Health guidance, school districts will also be required to include a remote learning option in the remote learning plan.
- This remote learning option was developed by the building and district administrative teams.



Remote Learning Protocols

- Choosing the Remote Learning Option is a commitment to stay in this learning environment for each quarter at the secondary level and each trimester at the elementary level.
- There will be a two-week grace period at the beginning of the year for students choosing to change their learning option.
- The remote learning environment is equivalent to a traditional classroom environment; therefore, please adhere to typical protocols.
- Communication regarding instruction should be addressed with the student's teacher outside of class time. Teachers will be communicating with students via email; students are expected to check their emails/Teams daily.
- Student behavioral expectations include attending all classes, arriving to class on time, appropriate dress, and being in an appropriate learning environment.

- All Seaford elementary students will be assigned to a classroom teacher who will remain the teacher of record.
- All students in the Seaford Harbor Elementary School and the Seaford Manor Elementary School in the Remote Learning Option will be receiving instruction by a Remote Learning Center Educator.
- All students in the Remote Learning Option will participate in all classes via a remote learning platform using either Microsoft Teams, Seesaw, and/or Zoom with their Remote Learning Center Educator.
- Students are committed to the Remote Learning Option for the entire trimester.
- Students will follow a remote learning schedule that aligns with the aspects of a student day as if the student was receiving in-person instruction. There will be a combination of synchronous and asynchronous lessons, keeping in mind screen time for our learners.
- Special Area instruction will take place in a synchronous and/or asynchronous manner.
- Please be reminded that online learning etiquette is expected to be followed at all times.

Provision of Remote Option Special Education Services



- The District will continue to provide program recommendations as indicated on the child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) during the remote learning option.
- Students will be assigned to a cohort and live-stream into the program as indicated on their IEP (e.g. special class, resource room, integrated co-taught classroom).
- Special education program services will be provided when the child is live-streaming in the classroom. Related services will be provided via teletherapy.

Provision of Remote Option English as a New Language(ENL) Services

- The District will continue to provide all ENL students with the Part 154 instructional requirements during the remote learning option.
- ENL co-teaching services will be provided as usual when an ENL student is live-streaming in their regular classroom (as determined by proficiency level: Entering, Emerging, Transitioning, Expanding, Commanding).
- ENL students will receive stand-alone remote ENL instruction as designated by individual proficiency levels.

Choosing the Remote Learning Option

At the conclusion of tonight's meeting, the District will send out a Shout Point message containing a link for the Remote Learning Option Form. This form needs to be completed by parents who wish to have their children participate in the Remote Learning Option.

The link will also be posted on the main page of the District website on Thursday, August 20.

The form needs to be completed by noon on Monday, August 24.
