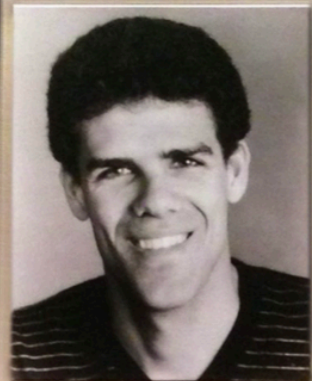

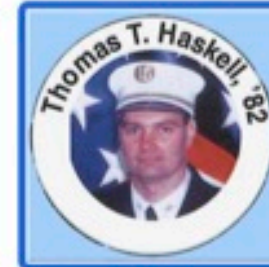
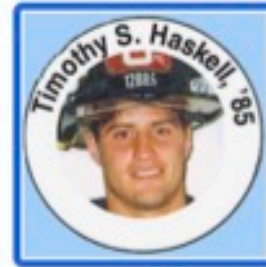

The Selection Process

- The Selection Committee is made up of family members, teachers, community members, past winners
- The Selection Committee will only look at Pages 2 and 3
- The Selection Committee will choose 10-15 finalists based on Pages 2 and 3 of the Application
- Finalists will be interviewed by family members of our honored alumni
- The Selection Committee chooses 5 Award Recipients based on the references and family interviews
- Patriot Award winners are announced at Graduation

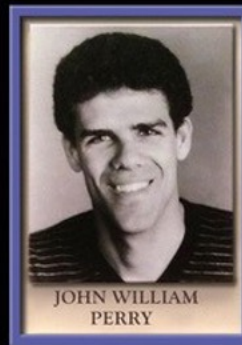

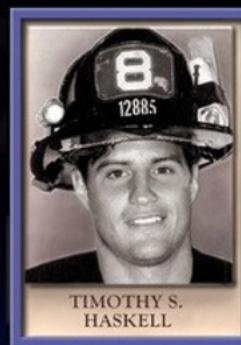

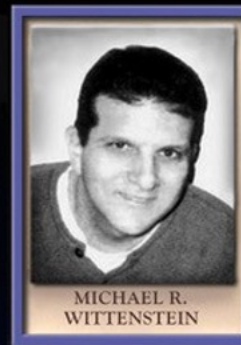
