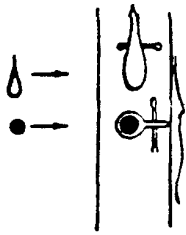


B \flat CLARINET FINGERING CHART

How To Read The Chart



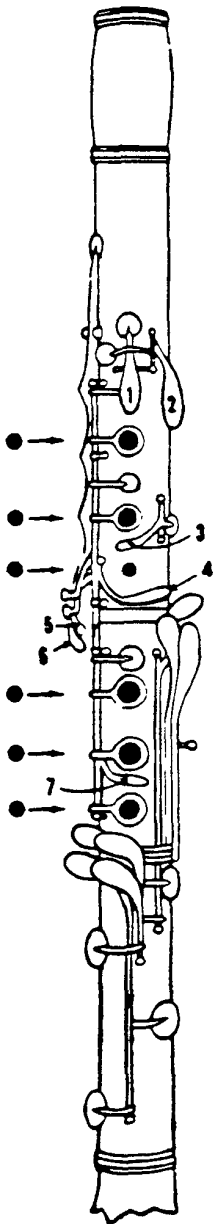
● - Indicates hole closed, or keys to be pressed.

○ - Indicates hole open.

When a number is given, refer to the picture of the Clarinet for additional key to be pressed.

When two notes are given together (F \sharp and G \flat), they are the same tone and, of course, played the same way.

When there are two fingerings given for a note, use the first one unless your teacher tells you otherwise.
